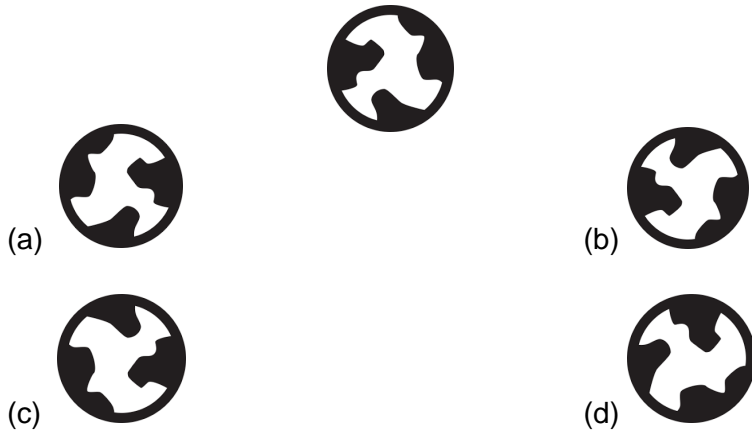

3. Which of the following will be the correct water image of the given figure?

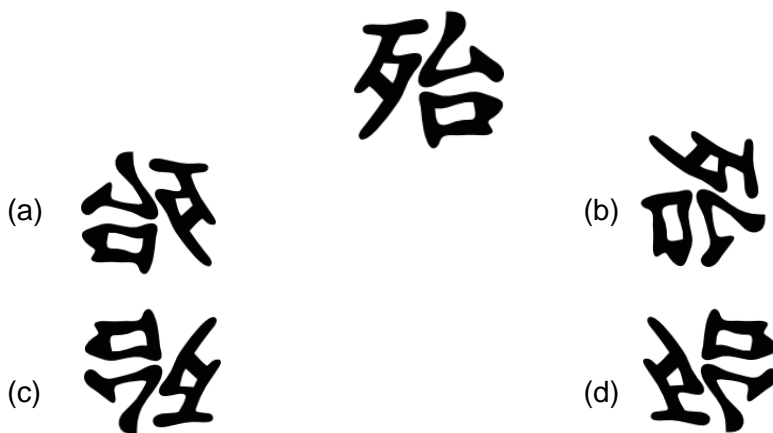
